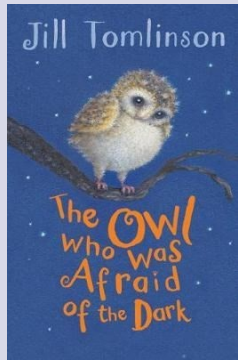

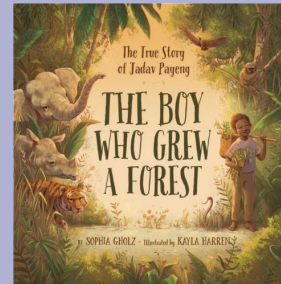
SPRING TERM

Stanley Lambchop was just an ordinary boy – until a noticeboard fell on him. Now he's flat as a pancake!

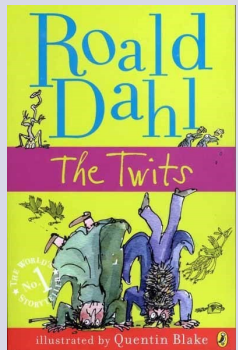

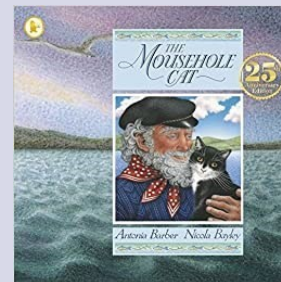


The Twits - Roald Dahl
