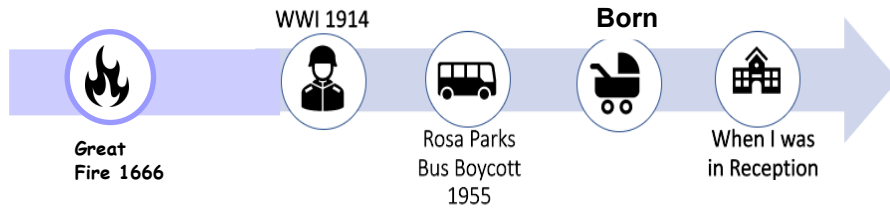

## The Significance of Rosa Parks

1913	Rosa Parks in born in Alabama, USA on the 4th February
1st December 1955	Rosa Parks was told to give up her seat on a bus for a white person—she said no
5th December 1955	Rosa Parks was arrested for breaking the law and was found guilty
December 1955—December 1956	The bus boycott took place to show support for Rosa Parks.
4th December 2005	Rosa Parks died

Boycott	Refusing to take part in something
Bus boycott	Black people in America, refused to take the bus to work, school or the shops
Rights	a moral or legal entitlement
Civil rights	Equal opportunities for everyone
Segregation	Placing people apart from others
Inequality	Something which is unfair
Legacy	Something left by someone.
