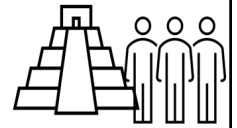

Afterlife	Life after death.
Hieroglyphics	The writing of hieroglyphs—an Egyptian language.
Mummification	To preserve a dead body as a mummy.
Pharaoh	A king of ancient Egypt.
Pyramid	A group of ancient pyramid-shaped structures built in Egypt as tombs for the pharaohs.
Reign	The period of rule.
Sarcophagus	A stone coffin, often decorated, that was used in ancient times.
Slave	A person who is the legal property of another and is forced to obey them, and works excessively.



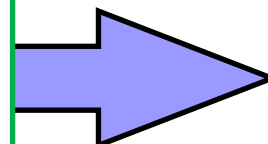
5000 BC
