


### What do I already know?

Pulse

The regular heartbeat of the music; its steady beat. It can be fast or slow or somewhere in between!

Pitch

High and low sounds

High pitch sound

Lion roar
Low pitch sound

Sound effects

A sound other than speech or music made artificially for use in a play, film, or other broadcast production.
