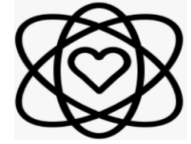

### What values do Christians have?



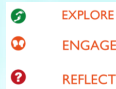
Values

Retell nativity story. (Christmas production)

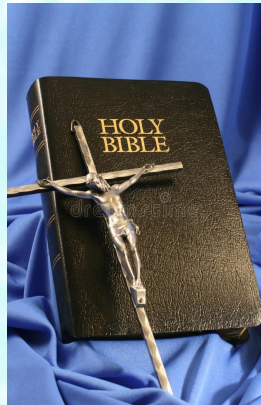
Hindus celebrate Diwali—Festival of light.

#### Key Vocabulary

<b>Christianity</b>	the religion based on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ, or its beliefs and practices.
<b>Celebrations</b>	An enjoyable activity to celebrate special moments
<b>Church</b>	A building used for public Christian worship
<b>Bible</b>	A collection of sacred texts
<b>Crucifix</b>	A representation of a cross with a figure of Christ on it
<b>Font</b>	A basin to hold holy water for baptism.
