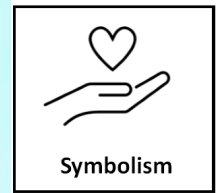

### What is the true meaning of Easter?

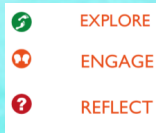


#### Essential Knowledge

- Know the bible defines Jesus' death as salvation for Christians.

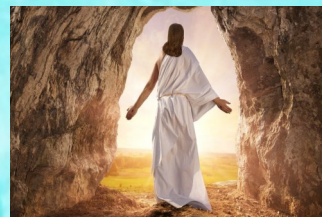


#### Review

#### Key Vocabulary

<b>Resurrection</b>	The rising of Christ from the dead.
<b>Symbols</b>	A thing that represents or stands for something else
<b>Lent</b>	A period of fasting and regret for one's sins that is observed on the 40 weekdays from Ash Wednesday to
<b>Sacrifice</b>	Christ's offering of himself on the Crucifixion
<b>Betrayed</b>	Not to be loyal to someone, often by doing something harmful.
<b>Salvation</b>	Being saved or protected by harm.
<b>Sin</b>	Doing something wrong and not following God's way.
