### Artist, craft-maker or designer: Andy Warhol



Andy Warhol was born in 1928 in Pennsylvania, USA. He was an artist who became famous for exploring popular culture through his artwork. As a child, Warhol had a serious illness called Sydenham's chorea. Whilst he was ill, Warhol would draw, listen to the radio and collect pictures of movie stars; this would later inspire his artistic style. As an adult, Warhol moved to New York and began his career illustrating adverts in fashion magazines. Warhol began to use printmaking to create artwork using repeated images from popular culture. His most famous print was based on a photograph of Marilyn Monroe, who was a famous movie star in the 1950s. Warhol enjoyed using bright colours and would switch colours in his prints to present a group of images in contrasting colours. Warhol also made films, digital artwork, installations, paintings and sculptures and is widely regarded as one of the most influential artists of all time.
