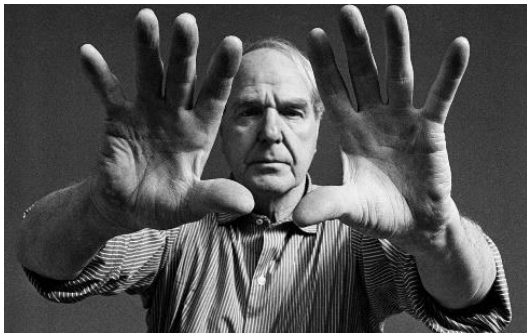

#### Henry Moore



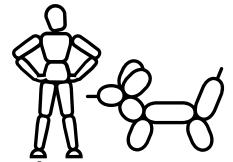
Henry Moore is famous for his sculptures of people. He was born in Yorkshire, England in 1898. He was a teacher and in the army before going to Leeds School of Art to learn how to become a sculptor. He was inspired by nature and created abstract forms with organic, natural and flowing shapes.
