- **Use simple sentences with a capital letter and full stop:**

The castle was haunted.

He was scary.

- **Use adjectives to describe nouns:**

The giant had an enormous beard.

The huge dinosaur had very sharp teeth.

- **Join words and clauses using 'and'**

The goblin ran away and jumped in the lake.

The princess had a shiny crown **and** a silver sword.

- **Use adverbials to sequence a narrative:**

Then they went to the woods.

Next, Big Billy Goat went to the river.

- **Use prepositions to describe where things are:**

The monster was inside the castle.

The goblin was under the table.
